

What are we doing?

We are carrying out stud removal works on Rusper Road, Newdigate in preparation for surface dressing due to take place later this year.



Information for residents and businesses

Rusper Road will be closed from Golf Course entrance to Church Road whilst we carry out these works.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business but there will be times when **delays are unavoidable**. Talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

- This type of work is weather dependent and bad weather means the work will be rescheduled.
- Due to the fast-moving nature of this type of work, dates can vary. If we're unable to work on the date on this leaflet, please make sure the road is left clear of vehicles the following working day.
- Please keep the road free from parked vehicles, otherwise it may be towed to a nearby road.

You can park on the road once the surface dressing is completed. You don't have to park elsewhere when we sweep the loose chippings.

My road looks fine, why is it having surface treatment when there are other roads that need it more?

Surface dressing is a preventative treatment used on roads in a good condition, to protect and prolong their life for up to 10 years.
